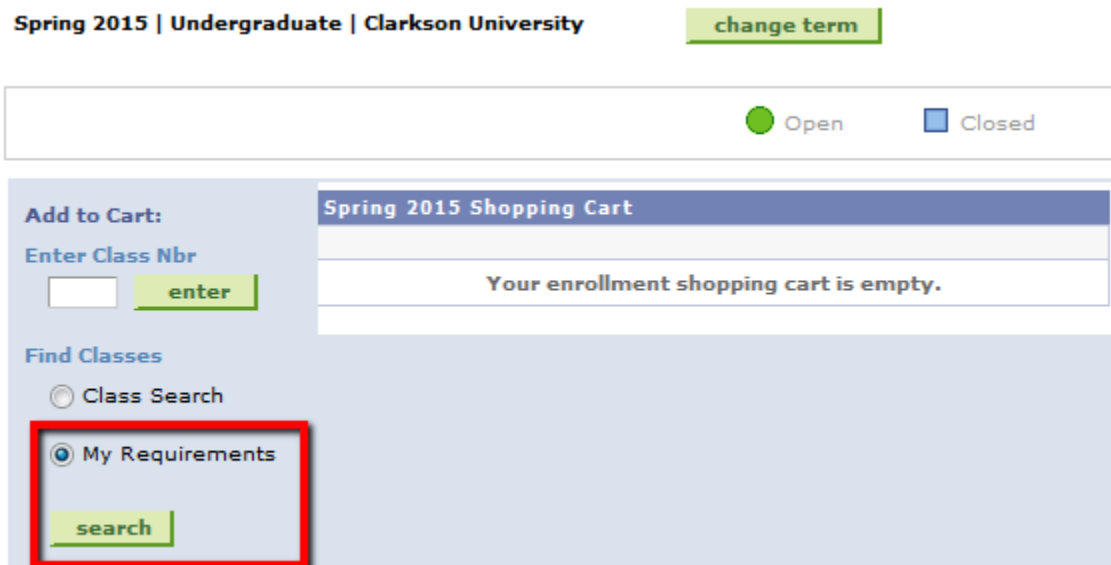
Use the Academic Advisement report to ensure you are taking classes you need to graduate!
